All Zimbabwean nationals who require the above listed consular services should visit any of the venues between 0900 to 1500 hours on the indicated dates. Please note that services will be provided on first come – first served basis at a maximum of 210 clients per day. The Consulate further urges all Zimbabweans accessing consular services to remain law abiding and orderly during their presence at the mentioned venues.

Please bring originals and photocopies for each application as per attached information document.

- 5. PARENTS' IDs (if it's in Zimbabwe it can be submitted there)**
- 6. PARENTS' PASSPORTS AND OR PERMITS**
- 7. MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE (if it is there)**

- 4. SAME PARENT'S PASSPORT & OR PERMIT**

APPLICATION FOR A PASSPORT - ADULTS (NEW APPLICATION OR RENEWAL)

ORDER OF PHOTOCOPIES FROM THE TOP

- 2. ID (Documents in Zimbabwe can be submitted there)**
- 3. PASSPORT (Affidavit if lost)**
- 4. WORK PERMIT AND OR PERMANENT RESIDENCE (If it's there)**
- 5. AND OR MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE (for women)**
